

## Resume

Jianfeng Yang, professor of School of Materials Science and Engineering, Xi'an Jiaotong University. He graduated from Xi'an Jiaotong University with bachelor's degree and master's degree respectively in 1985 and 1988. In 1999, he graduated from Osaka University, Japan, and obtained a doctor's degree. From 1999 to 2004, he was engaged in research in AIST of Japan, and in 2004, he was funded by Humboldt Foundation of Germany to engage in research in Germany for one year. He is a member of the American Ceramic Society, vice president of the Engineering Ceramics Branch of the Mechanical Engineering Society of China. He is editorial board member of the Journal of Xi'an Jiaotong University and the Journal of ceramics. Professor Yang has been engaged in the research of advanced ceramic materials and preparation technology for a long time, and has made many research results with great application value in the fields of non oxide ceramic materials, nano ceramic composite materials, porous ceramic materials, bioceramic materials, and related new devices and components. Since 2000, he has published more than 300 papers in journals and international academic conferences. 6 patents were authorized in Japan and 50 patents were authorized in China.
