He has received a number of awards and prizes including GSC Award (2004), Award from the Minister for Environment (2004), Yamazaki Teiichi Prize, Japan (2003), Award from the Society of Chemical Engineers, Japan (2003), and Award from the Society of Polymer Science, Japan (1992).
