

Ivar Reimanis is the Herman F. Coors Distinguished Professor of Ceramic Engineering in the Metallurgical and Materials Engineering Department at Colorado School of Mines in Golden, Colorado. He serves as Director of the Colorado Center for Advanced Ceramics. Dr. Reimanis earned a PhD in Materials at the University of California, Santa Barbara in 1990. He spent a year under a Max Planck Institute postdoctoral fellowship in Stuttgart, Germany. Dr. Reimanis worked as a postdoc at Los Alamos National Laboratory after which he served as a technical staff member until 1994 when he joined the Colorado School of Mines. He was awarded a United States Fulbright award in 2007 to spend a semester at the Indian Institute of Science in Bangalore. Dr. Reimanis is a Fellow of the American Ceramic Society, and he has served on ACerS Board of Directors and has volunteered in numerous other activities within ACerS. He currently serves as Associate Editor for the Journal of the American Ceramic Society and he is a member of the International Editorial Board for Ceramics International. He is a member of the World Academy of Ceramics. Dr. Reimanis has authored or co-authored about 120 refereed papers and five patents.
