

**Richard Todd** is Professor of Materials at the University of Oxford, and Goldsmiths' Fellow in Materials Science and Vice-Master of St. Catherine's College, Oxford. He has worked in the electronics industry, studied at the Universities of Cambridge and Oxford and held permanent positions at the Universities of Manchester and Oxford, UK.

Professor Todd's research interests revolve around the processing and mechanical behaviour of ceramics. He was the winner of the Pfeil Award of the Institute of Materials in 2001, the Verulam Medal and Prize of the Institute of Materials in 2012, the Stuijts Award of the European Ceramic Society 2019 and the Ross Coffin Purdy Award of The American Ceramic Society in 2019. He was elected a Fellow of the European Ceramic Society in 2013.

Professor Todd is also the Editor-in-Chief of *The Journal of the European Ceramic Society*, which has been ranked as the top ceramics journal every year since 2014.
