

Yujin Wang is a full professor of materials science, Harbin Institute of Technology (HIT). He received his BS (1996), MS (1998) and PhD (2002) in materials science from HIT, China. He joined the faculty of Materials Science and Engineering at HIT in 2002. He was a visiting scholar at Department of Aerospace Engineering, University of Bristol, UK in 2008 for four months. In 2013, he was awarded for the program of New Century Excellent Talents in University (NCEU) from the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China. In 2015, he was appointed as the head of Dept. Materials Science (HIT).

Professor Wang's research interests focus on Ultrahigh temperature materials (UHTMs), such as refractory metals, non-oxides of transition metals, especially their carbides and borides, etc. He has authored or coauthored more than 130 peer-reviewed journal papers. He has served as one of Committee Members of the Chinese Heat Treatment Society (CHTS) and the Chinese Engineering Ceramics Society (CECS); and one of the Youth Committee Members of the Chinese Materials Research Society (C-MRS).
