Dr. Chia-Yu Lin received his B.S. degree in Chemical Engineering from National Cheng Kung University, Taiwan, in 2003. He received his M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Chemical Engineering from National Taiwan University, Taiwan in 2005 and 2010, respectively. Thereafter, he joined Christian Doppler Laboratory for Sustainable SynGas Chemistry, Department of Chemistry, University of Cambridge, United Kingdom, as a postdoctoral researcher from 2011 to 2013.



Currently, he is an Associate professor in Department of Chemical Engineering, National Cheng Kung University, Taiwan. His research focuses on electrochemical reaction engineering in both synthesis and applications of energy materials. His work resulted in more than 45 publications in SCI peer-reviewed journals with an h-index of 23 (Web of science).
