

Dr. Shaorong Wang, Professor of China University of Mining and Technology (CUMT). He graduated from Dept. of Chemistry, Chengdu Univ. of Science & Technology, majored in Physical Chemistry, and then worked there for 8 years. In 1994, he went to Japan to study Solid Oxide Fuel Cells (SOFC), under the supervision of Professor H. Tagawa and M. Dokiya. Wang got his PhD degree in 1998 and then went to Electrical Technology Laboratory in Tsukuba for the Post Doctor research. After that, he worked in Nihon University for two years before returning to China in 2003.

Dr. Wang has been the group leader of SOFC research in Shanghai Institute of Ceramics for 13 years. His group was supported by 4 National High Tech. Developing “863” Projects and others. Dr. Wang is now the chief scientist of an innovation group. With his 25 years’ experience of SOFC research, he is interested in the commercialization of SOFC/EC technology.
