

Prof. Jian Zhang currently is the deputy director at the Research Centre for Transparent Ceramics, Shanghai Institute of Ceramics, Chinese Academy of Sciences (SICCAS). He got his PhD from SICCAS in 2005 and then he worked as a research assistant over there. From 2007 to 2012, he was the research fellow at University of Leeds (2007-2008), and Nanyang Technological University (2008-2012). His current research interests focused on processing science and technology for transparent ceramics (Garnet, Sesquioxide, Spinel and etc.), and exploring their optical and photonic applications such as laser gain media, optical windows, and etc. In the above area, he and his team published 220 papers in the international journals. He co-chaired the 7th (Singapore, 2011) and 11th (China, 2015) Laser Ceramics Symposium.
